To participate, you must:

- Reside in the United States, and
- Be able to read and understand English.

What will participation involve?

Participants will complete an **online Qualtrics survey**, which takes approximately **15–20 minutes**. At the end of the survey, you may choose to provide your contact information if you are interested in participating in an additional **30–60 minute Zoom interview** to share more about your experiences.

Compensation



There is no compensation for those who complete the Qualtrics survey. Participants who complete the optional Zoom interview will receive a **\$25 Amazon gift card** for their time.
